Where to fit Adaptor? (for LHD vehicles only)

Do you have 'traditional' headlamps with 'line patterns' in the front glass? Yes/No

You will have 'clear glass' headlamps with no 'fitting position' reference points.

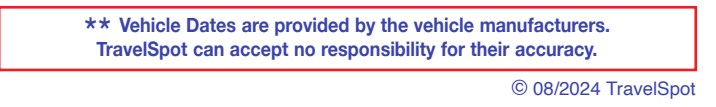
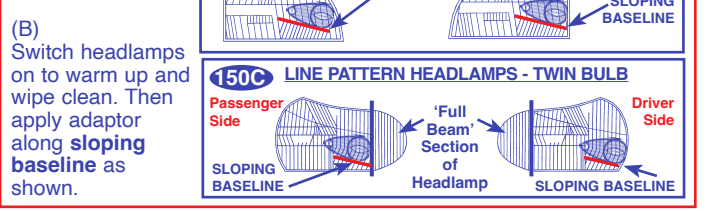
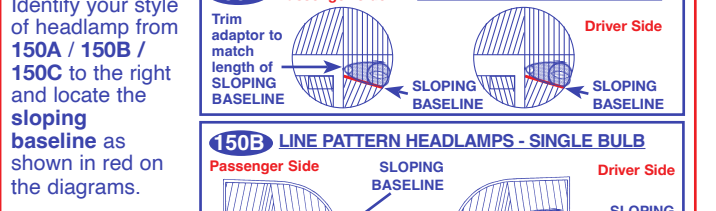

PART D Removal Warning

- For quick use video visit: www.eurosites.info/V5
- 1. Always remove your adaptors immediately upon return from the UK.
- 2. Switch on headlights to soften the adhesive before removal.
- 3. When removing the adaptors please ensure the ultra-thin adhesive 'carrier film' has also been peeled from the headlamp. Now allow headlights to cool before washing them.
- 4. Residual Adhesive - Any residual adhesive can be removed using plenty of hot soapy water or an alcohol based cleaner (e.g. Methylated Spirits or Neat Windscreen Wash).
- 5. DO NOT USE WHITE SPURT, THINNERS OR ACETONE BASED CLEANERS.
- 6. NOTE: Take care not to scratch or damage plastic headlamps where fitted.
